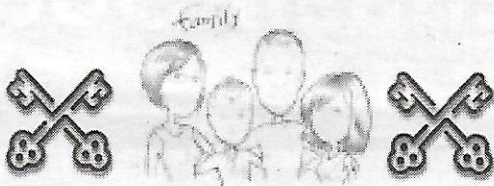


Cross Keys Treasure Hunt

Upwood & the Raveleys Newsletter

Upwood and the Raveleys Newsletter is a bi-monthly publication which was started by a group of interested parishioners 13 years and 79 editions ago.

During that time it has received an annual grant, representing approximately 50% of the overall publication costs, from the parish council but has had to supplement this amount with fund-raising and donations from other parish organisations, primarily the now defunct village fete. In order to make up this year's shortfall the newsletter committee is organising a family-orientated event in conjunction with the Cross Keys Public House on August Bank Holiday Sunday, 30th August.

There will be a walking treasure hunt with clues to be found at various places around the village. Anyone wishing to participate will need to collect a question sheet from the Cross Keys between 4pm and 5pm on the day. The trail should take about an hour to complete. Question sheets cost £2 per group. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

After that there will be a barbecue, wine raffle and live music at the Cross Keys. Among artists performing will be Upwood Ukuleles. All proceeds will go to Upwood and the Raveleys Newsletter.
